

₹1,390CR CONTRACT AWARDED FOR 28 STEEL BRIDGES



NHSRCL awards contract to build bridges along Mumbai-Ahmedabad High Speed Rail Corridor to Larson & Toubro-IHI Infrastructure Systems, a consortium of Indian and Japanese companies

28 steel bridges to be constructed

₹1,390 crore project cost

➤ Contract awarded for one mountain tunnel of 350m

70,000 MT of steel to be used for fabrication of bridges

➤ 28 steel bridges with individual span varying from 60m to 130m

➤ Contract awarded for 5 high-speed railway stations at Vapi, Billimora, Surat, Bharuch, Anand/Nadiad and a train depot in Surat

➤ Total length of 28 bridges is 4.5km
